WOMEN'S AUXILIARY ELEANOR ALLWORK SCHOLARSHIP

AWARD Multiple awards of up to \$7,500

DEADLINE March 15

PURPOSE Merit-based scholarship for architecture students with demonstrated financial need.

ELIGIBILITY Students seeking their first degree in architecture from an NAAB accredited school within the State of New York are eligible. The Dean or Chair of the architectural school shall nominate up to three students from their respective college or university to apply. Nominated students will have a high level of academic performance and evidence of financial need. The financial need of each student shall be determined by the guidelines of the Financial Aid Officer of the school nominating the candidate. Students need not be U.S. citizens.

NOTE A graduate student is eligible if completing his or her first architectural degree.

CENTER FOR ARCHITECTURE DESIGN SCHOLARSHIP

AWARD Single or multiple awards of up to \$5,000

DEADLINE March 15

PURPOSE Merit-based scholarship for students studying architecture, interior design, engineering, planning or a related design discipline with demonstrated financial need.

ELIGIBILITY Students seeking their first degree in a design discipline from an accredited school within New York State are eligible. The Dean or Chair of the accredited design program shall invite one student from his or her respective college or university to apply based on their high level of academic performance and evidence of financial need. The financial need of each student shall be determined by the guidelines of the Financial Aid Officer of the school nominating the candidate. Students need not be U.S. citizens.

NOTE A graduate student is eligible if completing his or her first design degree.

DOUGLAS HASKELL AWARD FOR STUDENT JOURNALS

AWARD Single award of up to \$2,000

DEADLINE May 1

PURPOSE Founded to encourage student journalism on architecture, planning and related subjects, and to foster regard for intelligent criticism among future professionals. The award is intended to support the ongoing publication of student-edited journals whose subject matter could include architectural design, history, and theory.

ELIGIBILITY Any student-edited journal (online or print) published by a school of architecture, landscape architecture or planning in the United States is eligible. The publication must have been produced within the two years prior to the date of application.

ARNOLD W. BRUNNER GRANT

AWARD Single award of up to \$15,000

DEADLINE February 1

PURPOSE Founded to encourage advanced study in any area of architectural investigation which will effectively contribute to the knowledge, teaching or practice of the art and science of architecture. Proposed investigations should result in a final written work, design project, research paper, or other form of presentation.

ELIGIBILITY Applicants must be a U.S. citizen engaged in the profession of architecture or a related field and have received their first professional degree at least five years prior to the date of application.

STEWARDSON KEEFE LEBRUN TRAVEL GRANT

AWARD Single or multiple awards of up to \$15,000

DEADLINE November 1

PURPOSE Founded to further the architectural education and professional development of an intern architect or an architect in their early to mid career through travel. Proposed travel plans should be focused on a selected topic of interest to the individual, rather than as part of a larger humanitarian or institutional endeavor. Travel plans need not result in a final end product.

ELIGIBILITY Applicants must be a U.S. Citizen with a degree in architecture and be a full-time practitioner, either licensed or unlicensed.
